dis·ci·ple Pronunciation: di-'sI-p&l Function: *noun*

Etymology: Middle English, from Old English *discipul* & Anglo-French *disciple*, from Late Latin and Latin; Late Latin *discipulus* follower of Jesus Christ in his lifetime, from Latin, pupil

Definition: One who accepts and assists in spreading the doctrines of another.

As disciples we are committed to the great commission made to us by Jesus Christ in NIV Matthew 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, **“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”**

Prayerfully, we will go out and meet with people in our area, invite them to visit and worship at our church, and welcome the opportunity to talk with anyone about Jesus. Our goal being to expose people to the word of God, and to show them how having Jesus in their lives can bring them a joy and peace they’ve never experienced before. Having done this, we will pray that if it be God’s will, many will become convicted, and receive Jesus into their hearts.

Questions to ask:

1. What is your name?
2. May we send you a brochure about our church later? If they say yes get their address.
3. Do you have children? Ages?
4. Do you attend a church? Have you been saved?
5. If not saved. Can I take a few moments of your time to discuss the Bible?
If they say yes then proceed to STEP ONE. If they say no, ask them if they have any prayer needs, pray with them and leave.

<p>STEP ONE</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Do you have any kind of spiritual belief? 2. To you, who is Jesus? 3. Do you believe there is a heaven and a hell? 4. If you died right now, where would you go? 5. If what you believe were not true, would you want to know it? <p>If the answer to 5 is (yes) then goto STEP 2. If the answer to 5 in (no) then thank the person for their time and leave.</p>	<p>STEP THREE</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Are you a sinner? 2. Do you want forgiveness for your sins? 3. Do you believe Jesus died on the cross for you and rose again? 4. Are you willing to surrender your life to Christ? 5. Are you ready to invite Jesus into your heart and into your life? <p>Be silent ... and pray.</p>
<p>STEP TWO (Use the NIV Bible Verse Sheet)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask the person to read each verse aloud. 2. After each verse ask, “What does this say to you?” <p>Now you are ready to use the closing question in Step Three.</p>	

NIV Bible Verse Sheet

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious standard.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 3:3 Jesus replied, "I assure you, unless you are born again, you can never see the kingdom of God."

John 14:6 Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me".

Romans 10:9-11, For if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. As the Scriptures tell us, "Anyone who believes in him will not be disappointed".

2 Corinthians 5:15 He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live to please themselves. Instead, they will live to please Christ who died and was raised for them.

Revelation 3:20 "Look! Here I stand at the door and knock. If you hear me calling and open the door, I will come in and we will share a meal as friends".

Prayer to Receive Jesus Into Your Life

If you believe these things, you can pray a prayer like the one below, to receive Jesus into your life, keeping in mind that merely saying a prayer in itself does not save you, for prayer is not like a magic charm or incantation. Only faith in Jesus Christ alone saves.

"Father in heaven, I come to you confessing that I am a sinner, completely lost and without hope. I repent of my sinful ways and ask for Your forgiveness. I believe in my heart that Christ Jesus is the Son of God, that He completely paid for all of my sins by His death on the cross, and that You raised Him from the dead. I confess that Jesus is my Savior and Lord. I trust in Him and Him alone, for my salvation. I believe that through His shed blood I have eternal life. I will pray, study, meditate and live by Your Word the rest of my life.

Father, I ask that You fill me with the Holy Spirit. Please come into my heart and save and sanctify my soul. I love you, Lord, and offer myself to You completely and without reservation. In the precious name of Jesus I pray.
